### **IMPORTANT PARENT REMINDERS**

Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! First and foremost, thank you in advance for your patience during the first week of school! We know that buses can be late and car lines are extremely long. Dismissal and Arrival do smooth out during the second week of school. The following are some reminders/information for our families:

- St. Lucie Public Schools has a mandatory mask policy for all students, staff and visitors on campus while indoors. Parents can opt out by going to the Family Access in Skyward and completing the simple form. Beginning Monday, all students will wear masks unless they have opted out.
- There is no supervision before 9:15 each day. Please do not bring your child to school before that time. If you arrive to drop off your child before 9:15, we ask that all children wait in your car until duty staff arrive at 9:15 to receive them. Please contact the Boys & Girls Club if you need to arrange before or after school care for your children(s).
- Walkers and Bike Riders will be dismissed at 4:00 pm. Parents and guardians of walkers will not be permitted to
  congregate on school grounds during arrival or dismissal. Students designated as "walkers" must keep moving and
  walk off campus to meet their parent/ siblings (past the crossing guard).
- Lunch visits for parents will be allowed this year when it is safe to do so. For the first month of school we will not have visitors due to the need for students to learn lunch routines and socialize with their peers. When families are allowed to visit, there will be limitations to the number of visitors. All lunch visits will take place in the outside dining area. Designated days will be established for specific grade levels to limit the number in the outside area. All visitors on campus must wear a mask.
- We ask all students to purchase a planner each year. The cost is \$5.00 and they can be bought through SchoolPay on our website.
- Don't forget to apply for the National School Lunch Program and complete the flyer and return it to school with your 5 digit code. Forms are due by August 17<sup>th</sup> for your child to receive a No Dress Code Pass for August 31<sup>st</sup>. You must reapply each year. Even if your child brings a lunch each day, we ask all families to apply because funds are attached to this program that benefit our school.
- When dropping off or picking up your child(ren) each day please remain in your vehicle. In order to expedite the car line, please have your child exit your vehicle at any pole that a staff member is present.
- Car signs need to be displayed on the car dash daily with student's name and Pik My Kid Code. You can make
  dismissal changes through PikMyKid or by calling the school. Dismissal changes cannot be made either way after
  3:15 each day.
- Kindergarten Car Line families, thank you for your patience as we work out a system that will satisfy the community
  and get our students dismissed safely. Please do not follow the route given to you any longer. For both drop off and
  dismissal, please come down Rowley, turn on to West Park and proceed directly to the car line. Please do not arrive
  early, that is when back ups will occur. When exiting the car line, you must turn right and go back down West Park
  to Rowley.
- Stopping in the road to drop off or pick up a child is unsafe and a safety concern for our students. Please refrain from doing this. Signs are clearly posted. It is also a ticketable offense.
- All walkers must use the cross walk following the direction of the crossing guard.
- We have 2 School Resource Deputies on our campus this year-Deputy Barrera and Deputy Stubley.

- Keeping our learning environment safe and secure for our students and staff is our top priority. All schools in SLPS
  are continuing to use the Entry Door Access Protocol at the main entrance. All visitors are expected to state the
  purpose of their visit and/or specify whom they have an appointment with by speaking through the intercom. All
  visitors must wear a mask and complete the Self Check Covid Screener before entering. Only those with business at
  school will be permitted inside. It is important that our visitors do no hold the door open for others. We appreciate
  your cooperation with these new procedures.
- Should the weather prevent us from having a regular dismissal, we have an Alternate Dismissal Plan is place. We ask that you are patient with us, as it takes a while to dismiss students safely when the weather is stormy. We will send a message through PikMyKid.
